DESIGNING BETTER BUS SERVICE EFFORT TO HOLD FIRST SERIES OF PUBLIC WORKSHOPS

DURHAM, N.C. – More than 21,000 people ride the Durham Area Transit Authority (DATA) every day. DATA provides a vital link to work, school, appointments and social events.

Citizens can play an important role in helping to shape Durham's growing transit system through an effort called "Designing Better Bus Service." Upcoming public workshops will help provide feedback to improve DATA's existing services given an unchanged level of financial resources. The sessions will offer the opportunity for open and honest discussions about transportation issues that are important to Durham residents and the Durham community. The workshops follow outreach that occurred this spring that collected information from rider surveys, major employers and city departments on transit.

At the workshops, the public can review materials and provide comments. DATA, management partner Triangle Transit and the City of Durham want the feedback to ensure the diverse needs of the community are considered in evaluating current and future service.

- 4 p.m. to 7 p.m. – Durham Station, 515 W. Pettigrew St. (Parking is limited.) Transit is available on all DATA Routes and Triangle Transit Routes 400 and 700.
- 7 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. – Fullsteam Brewery, 726 Rigsbee Ave. (Parking is limited.) Transit is available on DATA Route 4.

Wednesday, November 16

- 8:30 a.m. to 10:30 a.m. – Durham Center for Senior Life, 406 Rigsbee Ave. Transit is available on DATA Route 4.

- 11 a.m. to 2 p.m. – Outside the NCCU Student Union (Parking is limited.) Transit is available on DATA Routes 5 and 13.
